DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From Klamath Falls:

Take Hwy 39 south (turns into 139 in California) going past Tulelake approximately 20 miles. Just past alfalfa on the right and farmground on the left, turn left on Co Rd 136 (Clear Lake Rd). This road is a gravel road and is just after you go over a railroad overpass. Go appx. 2 miles. Field is on left.

From Alturas:

Take 299 west, turn right on Hwy 139 just past Canby. Go appx. 30 miles. Turn right on Co Rd 136 (Clear Lake Rd). This road is a gravel road and is just before you go over a railroad overpass. Go appx. 2 miles. Field is on left.
